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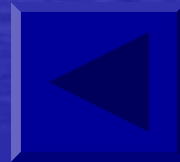

My favorite subjects are Math & Science

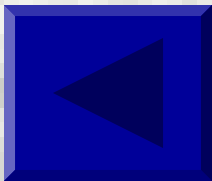
I don't like getting beat

I am Gerald Loveless II

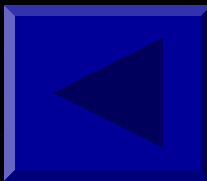


# Free Verse

But instead, we live in a world of death.

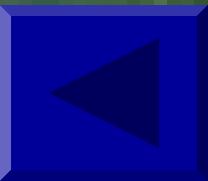


# Elegy

He died after surgery

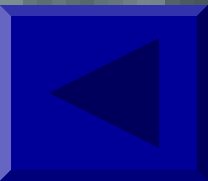
If I had 1 wish, I'd wish this

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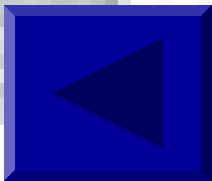
# Simile

- Definition: compares two unlike things using the words like, as
- Example: My fist are as hard as Iron



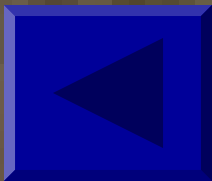
# Metaphor

- Definition: compares two unlike things NOT using the words like, as
- Example: Life is a game



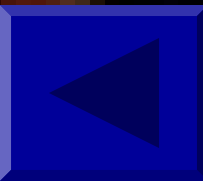
# Assonance

- Repetition of vowel sounds in words close together
- Example: See my Speeding feet sweep past everyone.



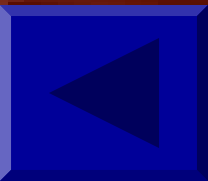
# Symbol

- Person, place, things or events that has meaning in itself and stands for something beyond itself as well
- Example: A flaming American flag stand for terrorist.



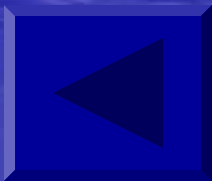
# Personification

- Definition: Giving animals or objects human traits or characteristics.
- Example: The Mad Mars



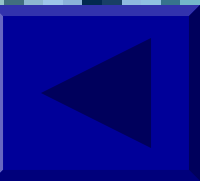
# Onomatopoeia

- Words whose sounds imitate or suggest meanings
- Example: Boom



# Alliteration
